

Apache2: Whitelist & htpasswd

1. Créer un fichier password:

```
htpasswd -c /usr/local/apache/passwd/site-passwords vincent
```

2. Modifier le fichier de config apache2

```
nano /etc/apache2/sites-enabled/site.conf
```

    SSLCertificateKeyFile /etc/letsencrypt/live/site/privkey.pem
    Include /etc/letsencrypt/options-ssl-apache.conf

```

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
