

Microsoft SQL Server sur Ubuntu 20.04

1. Mettre à jour le système

```
apt update  
apt dist-upgrade
```

2. Installer quelques paquets nécessaires

```
apt install gnupg curl software-properties-common
```

3. Ajouter la clé du repository MS

```
wget -q0- https://packages.microsoft.com/keys/microsoft.asc | sudo apt-  
key add -
```

4. Ajouter le repository

```
add-apt-repository "$(wget -q0-  
https://packages.microsoft.com/config/ubuntu/18.04/mssql-server-2019.li  
st)"
```

5. Installer

```
apt update  
apt install mssql-server
```

6. Configurer mssql

```
/opt/mssql/bin/mssql-conf setup
```

Choisir 3 - Express

7. Reste en vrac:

```
curl https://packages.microsoft.com/keys/microsoft.asc | sudo apt-key  
add -  
curl https://packages.microsoft.com/config/ubuntu/19.10/prod.list >  
/etc/apt/sources.list.d/mssql-release.list  
apt update  
  
apt-get install mssql-tools unixodbc-dev  
  
echo 'export PATH="$PATH:/opt/mssql-tools/bin"' >> ~/.bash_profile
```
